RULES:

- Open to any front or rear wheel drive car
 - No AWD or 4X4 vehicle
- Must have all trim, glass, carpet, extra seats not being used, headliner, trash, and tools removed from the vehicle.
 - Trim pieces include but are not limited to lights, mirrors, excessive emblems near areasthat can be hit, basically anything that can fall off when hit.
- Must have a seat belt
 - 4 point harness is recommended
- Must have a fully loaded fire extinguisher mounted within reach of the driver.
- The battery must be relocated inside of the car and securely mounted to the passenger floorboard, completely tied down and covered for your protection.

- Stock gas tanks are ok if they are in front of the rear axle. If they are behind the axle, they mustbe moved inside of the car and securely mounted.
 - Boat tanks are ok, they just have to have new fuel lines and be securely mounted in thetrunk or rear seat and covered.
 - If you have an electric fuel pump then you must have a securely mounted and accessiblefuel cut-off switch for officials, and the car must be marked with an E on the roof.
- Holes in the firewall on the inside of the car must be covered for fire safety.
- Screen on the front window is a must, either metal mesh with holes big enough to see through and small enough to catch debris from other cars on track.
 - The front windshield bar from the top of the windshield to the cowl must be used at aminimum of 2" x 1/4" flat strap.
 - A screen on the driver's window is also recommended.
- Mud flaps are to be run no matter what, behind the drive tires including front-wheel drive.
 - If running skid steer or tractor tire type on a rear-wheel drive you have to have your fullrear end "skirted" securely from the driver's side to the passenger side to ensure the safetyof the crowd.
- Fire holes must be cut in the hood a minimum of 12x12 for fire dept access.
- Bumpers front and rear can be homemade or stock but cannot have any jagged cuts, extend wider than the car except to wrap around/protect fenders, and have to have clean non-sharp, or jagged cuts.
- Roll bar must be a minimum of 2 posts behind the driver's seat from the floor to the roof.
 - H bar is recommended
 - Metal for both is a minimum of 2 x 2 x 1/4
- Dash bar is recommended at a minimum of 2 x 2 x 1/4
- Drivers door bar is required
 - Minimum of 6 x 1/4 channel or square tubing
 - o A Full Roll cage is recommended
